The following rules make a traditional Calcutta... **FatBracket**, a crafted, friendly game perfected to enhance the lives of college basketball enthusiasts. Enjoy!

Calcutta Organization

The live auction is separated into two batches:

- Batch 1: 60 teams seeded 3-16
- Batch 2: 8 teams seeded 1-2

Bidding Process and Limits

The auctioneer pulls teams up for bid at random, 60 teams in the first batch and 8 teams in the second batch.

Batch 1: Seeds 3-16 (60 Teams) - Bid Limit: 500

The auctioneer pulls the first team out and states the starting bid and bidding increments. It is solely at the auctioneer's discretion to accept a bid lower than being sought. Typically bid increments sought are 10 percent higher than the current bid, and the auctioneer can deny bids less than 10 percent higher at their sole discretion.



Players may bid any amount they choose on teams. To create balance in the first round of the auction, once a player expends more than 500 points, they may not bid on any more teams during the first batch.

Example: Player BUTTKICKERS has acquired three teams for a total of 500 points exactly. BUTTKICKERS may continue to bid any amount desired on remaining teams as they have not exceeded 500 bid points. So they can buy Duke, as an example, for 400 points putting them at 900 total points expended in Batch 1: BUTTKICKERS may no longer bid until Batch 2.

Once a team has been claimed by a FatBracket player, the player must confirm the team and winning bid amount before the auction continues.

Batch 2: Seeds 1-2 (8 Teams) Bid Limit: No Limit

The auction continues at random, now with just 8 teams. All players, regardless if they surpassed the 500 bid limit in Batch 1 or not may bid any amount they choose on teams in Batch 2. There is no limit on bidding in Batch 2. NOTE: Colluding often occurs- keep all bids in the name of one player.

Team Dividends

Dividends are earned by players based on their acquired teams' performances. Players receive dividends by:

- Winning games within the field of 64.
- Props, including the First Four, Blowout Specials and Biggest Upsets

Winning Games Dividends (86% of Total)

Every time a team wins, they earn dividends. Those dividends grow in size as teams advance in the tournament. The table below shows the cumulative dividend distributions once the tournament is over, by team and as a percentage of the total points bid. Notice that while 32 teams win their first game, only 16 teams finish the tournament with just one win.

Prop Dividends (14% of Total)

Props include the First Four Play-in Games of the tournament typically played on Tuesday and Wednesday, and the Biggest Blowout and Biggest Upsets in the games played in round 2 (formerly Round 1) played on Thursday and Friday.

First Four Play-in Games

First Four wins earn 0.5% of the pot back in dividends, and live to play another game. The next game they play makes them eligible for a win as well as Blowout and Upset props. First Four teams demand a larger bid than if the team was not in the First Four. It is a great dynamic to FatBracket. NOTE: If your auction is held during or after the First Four games, the work-around is to auction both teams off at the same time knowing one game winning dividend is already in hand.

Blowouts

Blowouts are calculated by the largest differential in points between the winning team and losing team. The team LOSING by the most points claims the Blowout 1 dividend. The team losing by the second most points claims Blowout 2 and the team losing by the third most points claims Blowout 3. Should a tie occur, the teams and dividends are pooled and split equally.

Blowouts Tie Pooling and Splitting Dividends Example:

Duke 92, Winthrop 43 (49 point loss: B1 3.0%)
Maryland 78, DePaul 36 (42 point loss splits B2 and B3 1.5%)
Kansas 84, VCU 42 (42 point loss splits B2 and B3 1.5%)
UCLA 82, San Francisco 42 (40 point loss. No dividend)

UPSETS are based exclusively on tournament seeding. Teams seeded 9 - 16 are eligible to receive this prop's dividends. Should a tie occur, the teams and dividends are pooled and split equally. Example (2021):

#15 Oral Roberts beat #2 Ohio St (U1, 3.0%)

#14 Abilene Christian beat #3 Texas (U2 2.0%)

#13 North Texas beat #4 Purdue (U3 Split (0.5%)

#13 Ohio beat #4 Virginia (U3 Split (0.5%)


